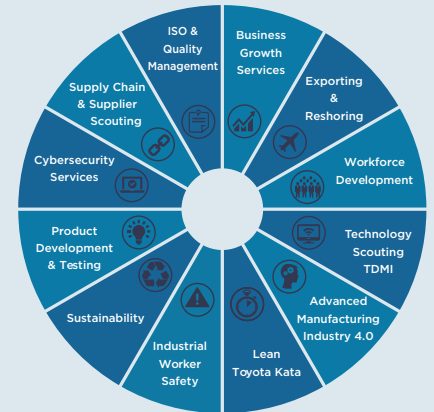

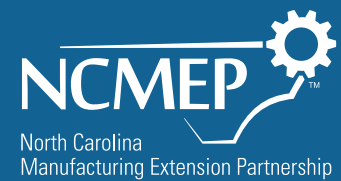
## Manufacturing Support

The MEP program was created in 1988 by the Omnibus Trade and Competitiveness Act to improve the competitiveness of U.S. manufacturing by making manufacturing technologies, processes and services more accessible to small and medium-sized manufacturers (SMMs) with Centers in every state and Puerto Rico.

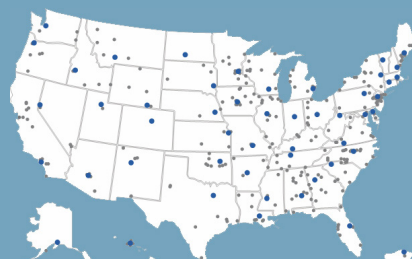
